



Gosper County Board Minutes

A meeting of the Gosper County Board of Commissioners was convened in open and public session at 9:00 a.m. on September 9, 2020, at the Gosper County Courthouse, Elwood, Nebraska. Present were Chairperson Terry Lerdall, and Members Glen Monter and Bruce Bader. Clerk Cynthia Evans was present to record the proceedings.

Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by publication in the Valley Voice, Cambridge, NE on Sept. 3, 2020. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the published notice. All proceedings of the Board were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

The undersigned Clerk hereby certifies that these minutes were written and available for public inspection within ten (10) working days after the date of said meeting.

The meeting was duly called to order and Chairman Lerdall announced and informed the public that a current copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act is posted on the wall of the meeting room.

The Minutes of August 31, 2020 were read. Motion by Bader, seconded by Monter to approve the minutes as read. Roll Call Vote: "Aye" Monter, Lerdall, Bader, motion carried.

Marty Craig, Dawson/Gosper County Weed Supt. was present and gave a weed report.

Motion by Monter, seconded by Bader to approve the Clerk of the District Court Report for August. Roll Call Vote: "Aye" Monter, Lerdall, Bader, motion carried.

At 10:00 a.m., Chairman Lerdall opened the Public Hearing in compliance with the provisions of State Statute Sections 13-501 to 13-513 for the purpose of hearing support, opposition for the FY2020-2021 Gosper County Budget. No one appeared. Clerk Cynthia Evans reviewed the Notice of Budget Hearing and Budget Summary document that was published in the Valley Voice on September 3, 2020. Chairman Lerdall closed the Public Hearing. Motion by Lerdall, seconded by Monter to approve the FY2020-2021 Gosper County Budget. Roll Call Vote: "Aye" Monter, Lerdall, Bader, motion carried.

At 10:15 a.m., Chairman Lerdall opened the Public Hearing in compliance with the provisions of State Statute Section 77-1601.02 for the purpose of hearing support, opposition, to adopt a property tax request different than the prior year tax request. No one appeared. Chairman Lerdall closed the Public Hearing. Motion by Bader, seconded by Lerdall to approve **Resolution No. 20-7** setting the Property Tax Request for FY 2020-2021 at \$2,055,982.76. Roll Call Vote: "Aye" Monter, Lerdall, Bader, motion carried.

Motion by Monter, seconded by Lerdall to approve **Resolution No. 20-8** which states the FY2020-2021 budget was adopted with \$1,085,124.15 funds budgeted in the County General Miscellaneous Fund necessary for maintenance of county roads and bridges, which is hereby transferred from the County General Fund to County Road and Bridge Fund. Roll Call Vote: "Aye" Monter, Lerdall, Bader, motion carried.

Motion by Bader, seconded by Lerdall to approve the Pledged Security Reports from Pinnacle Bank dated 8/31/20 and Security First Bank dated 9/1/20. Roll Call Vote: "Aye" Monter, Lerdall, Bader, motion carried.

Hwy. Supt. Mike Snyder was present and gave a road report. The Road employees have finished the project on Road 427 between Hwy. 283 and Hwy 23, they will seed the Schutz-Farr project and build fence, they will then start on the Mischler bridge project. The culvert has been ordered for the project on 730HI east west of Road 437 HI, Evans Construction will put the culvert in and do the dirt work. The South County shop was vandalized, discussion was held regarding adding security cameras to all shops.

The Board adjourned at 11:40 a.m.
